11. The meeting adjourned at 12 Noon.

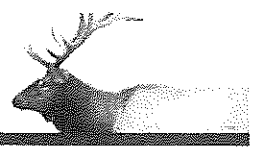
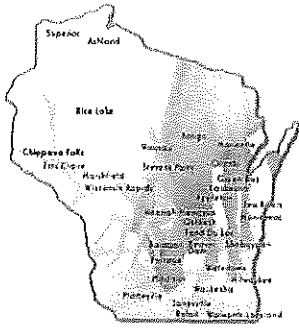

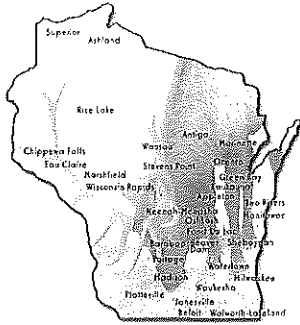

Meeting Notes from Drug Awareness Committee Meeting

May 4, 2023

Committee Chair: Cristine Crum

Attendance collected from roster.

Meeting opened at 10:05am with Pledge of Allegiance and information packets distributed.

Enrique Camarena Award:

The award program was refreshed to the committee and paperwork provided in the packet. Members are encouraged to start up this program in their lodges. Kelly from Green Bay 259 shared an example and her experience with this process and emphasized it is easy to support this award.

Poster & Video Contests:

Information for the poster contest was provided in the packet. Lodges participating are reminded to use the "Hold Harmless Waiver" for all poster applicants. The theme for this year's poster and video contests will be announced in July after the National Convention. There is also a DAP Essay contest available for lodges to take advantage of in their communities. So far, no lodges in Wisconsin have conducted the Video or Essay contests. Lodges are encouraged to check out these contests and additional details can be downloaded from the Elk's DAP website. More information about these contests will be provided after the National Convention.

Miscellaneous Topics:

A paper about the drug **Xylazine** was shared for awareness by the committee members. This is a growing problem similar to how fentanyl has emerged. Xylazine is a non-opioid sedative. It is used as a pet tranquilizer and is not regulated and very easy to get.

Reminder for all lodges to get Naloxzone (Narcan) kits into their lodges. Several lodges have done so already. This is not only to help reverse overdose by drug users/addicts, but can protect our members and guests from the risks of fentanyl that may exist in prescription drugs from websites or other un reputable sources.

Naloxzone training opportunities from DHS were shared with the group. Cris is planning to take this training soon.

Judge Davis from Michigan was mentioned as a possible future speaker. The judge has a strong anti-drug story that could be shared with the DAP committee or broader Elk's Association. No fee but would need to pay for travel expenses.

Open Sharing of Ideas or Suggestions:

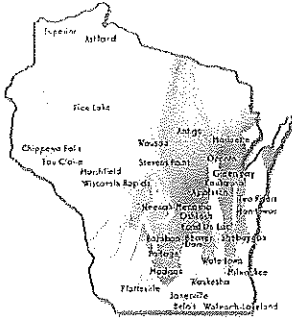
- Good idea to leave DAP material in Geo Caches.
- Jerry shared an experience of local stores having THC in vending machines and is concerned this would promote a negative path for our youth. The Elk's collaborated with local community groups to lobby the local establishments and the community pressure was successful in having these machines removed.
- Many drug/vape paraphernalia items are disguised to look like common items. Check with web for "Hiding in Plain Sight" for examples of these items.
- Wisconsin was one of several states to settle with drug companies for an "opioid mis-use" lawsuit. It is expected that large funds will be coming to Wisconsin, perhaps funneled to local drug coalitions.
- During the 2024 National Convention DAP session, Cris will be presenting training on methods for her cable access program targeted at drug awareness. Cris has also posted these programs on her Facebook and is on "Knowledge Is Power" website.
- A shoe holder stand is a good idea for displaying DAP literature.
- National Night Out should be occurring in most communities this summer. It is a good venue for lodges to participate in and provide our Elk's Drug Awareness Program.
- Lodges are encouraged to conduct fundraising to support local lodge DAP needs. Also look at grant opportunities in your lodges.
- There was good open discussion and sharing on other current events and issues related to drug abuse.

Legacy Scholarship winners for WI were distributed.

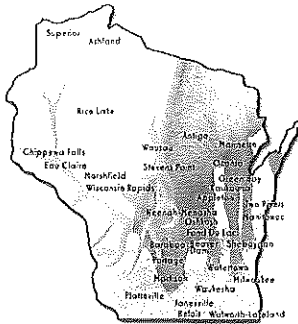
Scholarships have received \$194,000 for 24-25 Lodge year so Technical Scholarships this year will be \$1,500.

The meeting closed at 9:25 AM.

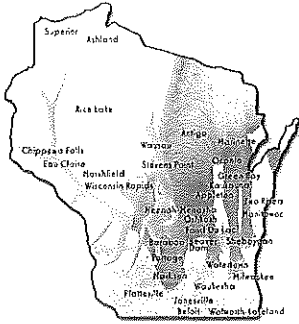

Committee Name Hoop Shoot

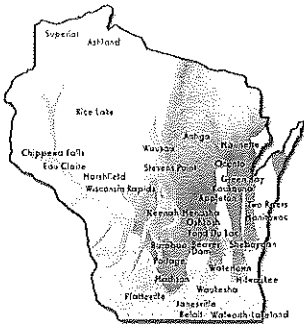
